Leadership Opportunities with The Church Network

Please review the descriptions and qualifications below and check your area(s) of interest:

[] Awards Committee

The purpose of this committee is to recognize members of TCN who are demonstrating exemplary work in the field of church administration. The committee will collect nominations and determine the Recipients of the association's special awards. Members serve a three-year term limit on a rotating basis. The term begins October 1st each year.

[] Board of Directors

The management and direction of the business of The Church Network is vested in the Board of Directors. The Board, on behalf of the association's membership, is to see that The Church Network achieves appropriate results for appropriate persons at an appropriate cost. The Board assesses the financial and professional health of the Network, promotes ethical behavior and standards among the membership, assesses and updates Bylaws, if needed, and develops potential leadership. Members may serve four one-year terms. The term begins each year at the annual conference.

[] Conference Planning Team

The purpose of this team is to support the TCN Annual Conference through planning, preparation, enlisting and training volunteers, and implementing those plans for a successful conference. Another key function of this team is to evaluate each part of the conference so adjustments can be made to improve processes and the attendee experience the following year.

[] Development Committee

The purpose of this committee is to raise funds for the network by developing and implementing fundraising campaigns at the direction of the Board of Directors. Members serve a three-year term limit on a rotating basis. The term begins October 1st each year.

[] Endowment Investment Committee

The purpose of this committee is to manage the Endowment Fund. The duties and responsibilities of this committee are outlined in the Endowment Fund Investment Policy (P-3). Members serve a three-year term limit on a rotating basis. The term begins October 1st each year.

[] Governance Committee

The purpose of this committee is to identify from among current TCN membership suitable leadership talent for members of the Board of Directors and make suggestions to the President for appointments to the Board committees. Governance is a Board committee and reports solely to the Board to assist it with assessment of governance, evaluation and leadership development. Members serve a three-year term limit on a rotating basis. The term begins April 1st each year.

[] Professional Training and Standards Committee

The purpose of this committee is to assist individuals serving Christ through administration in local churches to achieve the highest level of professional competence. It recommends to the Board professional training, standards, and criteria for certification and receives certification standards from denominations and other religious organizations. Members will serve a three-year term limit on a rotating basis. The term begins each year at the annual conference.
